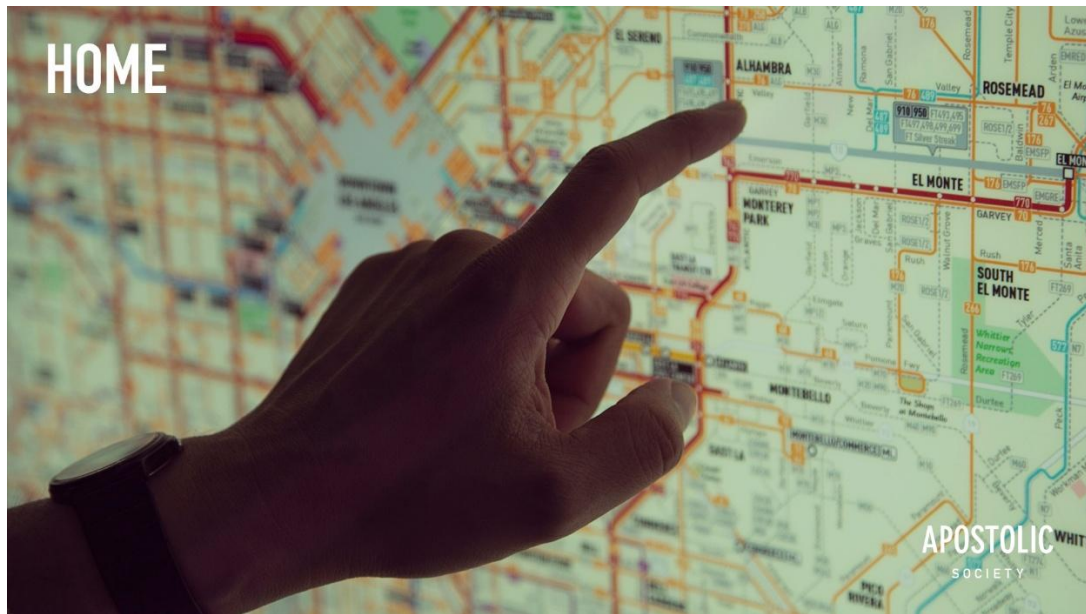


# Home
